



HOW TO APPLY

Undergraduate

- 1. Apply online from October 1 May 1
- 2. English Proficiency (submit one of the following)
- TOEFL: 550 paper/213 computer/80 iBt
- IELTS: 6.5
- ALI TOEFL waiver: Attend ALI, pass level 106,
 3.0 gpa and teacher recommendation
- 3. Submit official high school transcripts
- SAT required only from students attending a U.S. accredited high school
- Transfer students must first complete the equivalent of two years of university course work (60 semester units)

Graduate

- 1. Apply online
- Deadlines are set by the departments and are posted at: www.sdsu.edu/gradrequirements
- 2. English Proficiency (submit one of the following)
- TOEFL: 550 paper/213 computer/80 iBt
- IELTS: 6.5
- ALI TOEFL waiver: Attend ALI, pass level 106, 3.0 gpa and teacher recommendation
- 3. Submit all university/college transcripts and proof of degree.
- 4. Test Requirements
- GMAT Graduate Business requires 540 (at least 25 percent in each section; at least 3.5 on writing segment).
- GRE Required by all graduate programs (except business). Minimum score varies by department.
- 5. Submit additional department requirements found at: www.sdsu.edu/gradrequirements
