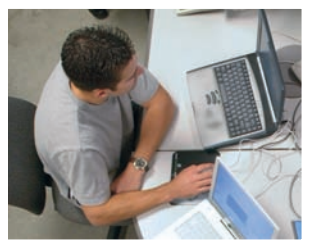

HOW TO APPLY

Undergraduate

1. Apply online from October 1 – May 1
2. English Proficiency (submit one of the following)
 - TOEFL: 550 paper/213 computer/80 iBt
 - IELTS: 6.5
 - ALI TOEFL waiver: Attend ALI, pass level 106, 3.0 gpa and teacher recommendation
3. Submit official high school transcripts

NOTE:

- SAT required only from students attending a U.S. accredited high school
- Transfer students must first complete the equivalent of two years of university course work (60 semester units)

Graduate

1. Apply online
 - Deadlines are set by the departments and are posted at: www.sdsu.edu/gradrequirements
2. English Proficiency (submit one of the following)
 - TOEFL: 550 paper/213 computer/80 iBt
 - IELTS: 6.5
 - ALI TOEFL waiver: Attend ALI, pass level 106, 3.0 gpa and teacher recommendation
3. Submit all university/college transcripts and proof of degree.
4. Test Requirements
 - GMAT — Graduate Business requires 540 (at least 25 percent in each section; at least 3.5 on writing segment).
 - GRE — Required by all graduate programs (except business). Minimum score varies by department.
5. Submit additional department requirements found at: www.sdsu.edu/gradrequirements
